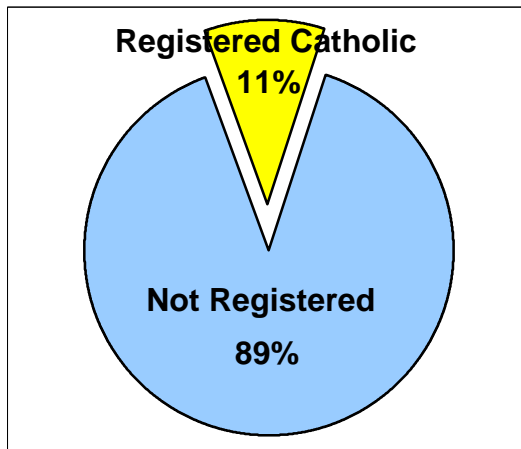

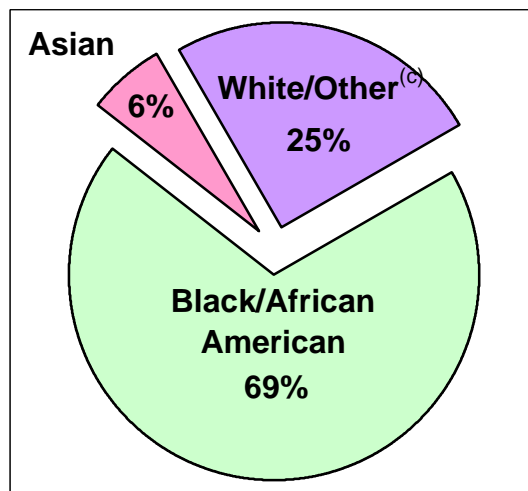
Based on the 2000 Census and 2000 Annual Pastoral Reports,  
What share of the people living in the cluster territory are Catholic?



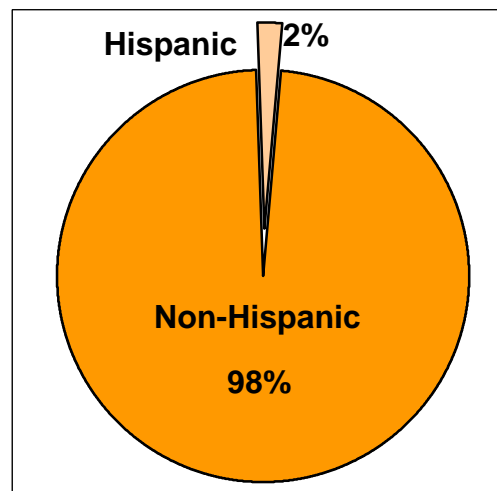

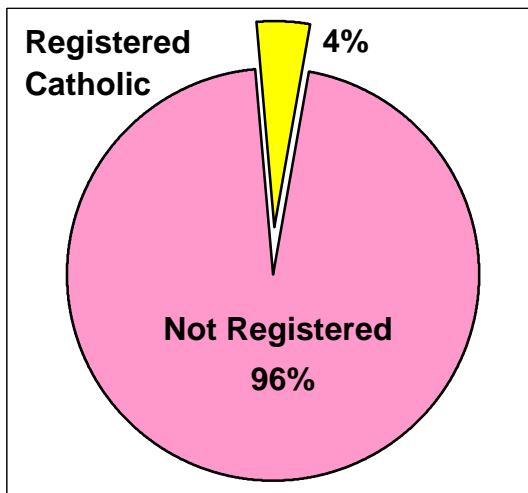

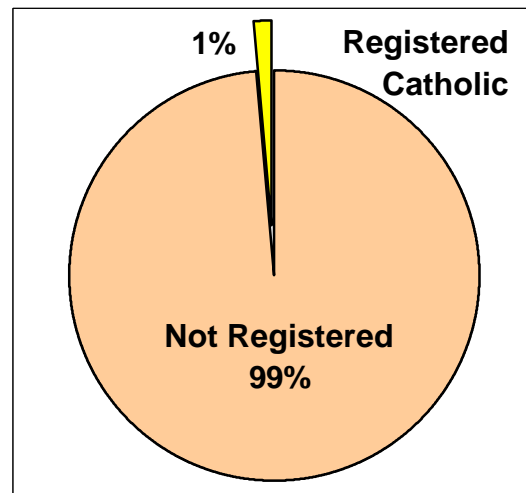

What percentage of each group living in the cluster is Catholic?

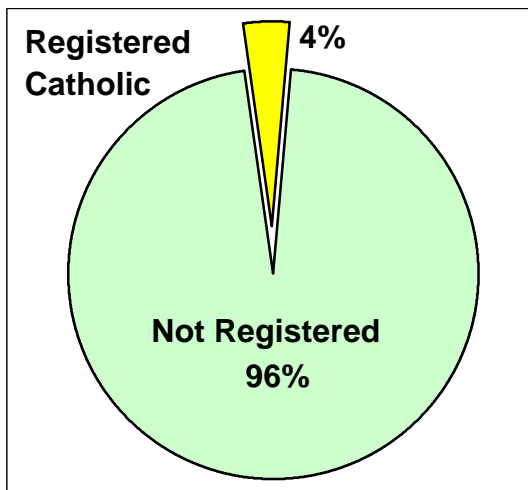
**Asian**



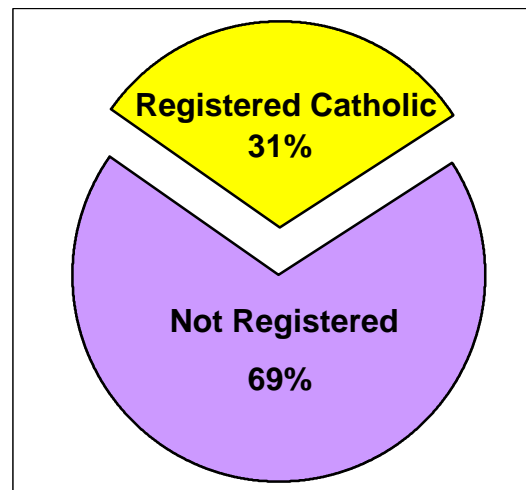
**Hispanic**
